We will be putting out a community mailer to keep the community updated on our work since the merger.

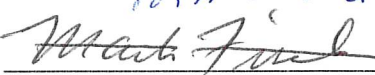

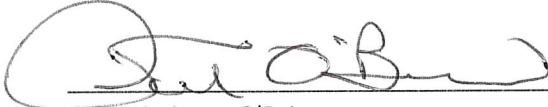

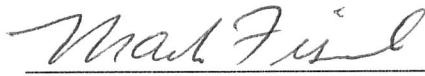
